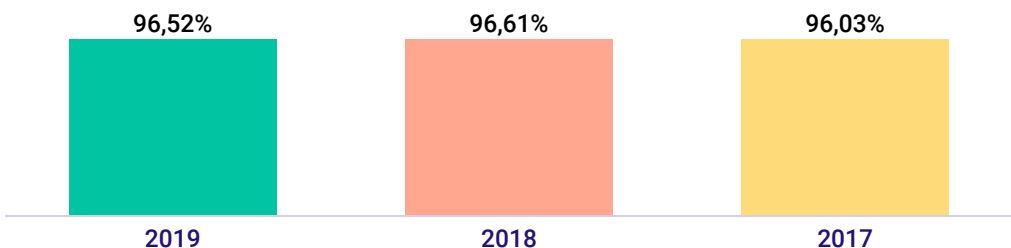

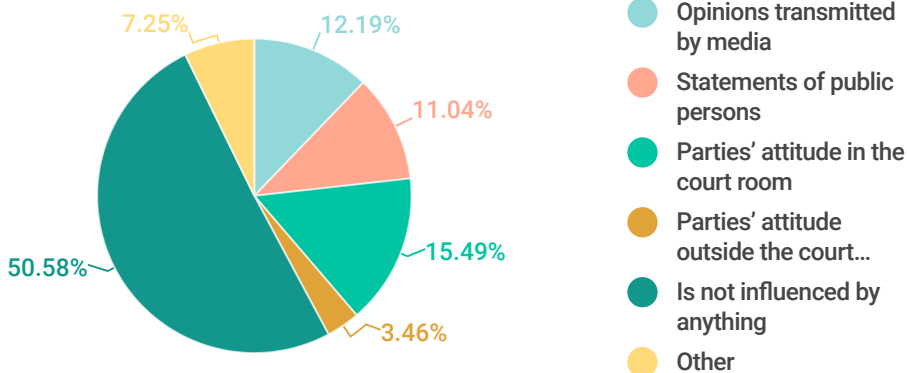

Extra-legal circumstances influencing the judges' decision-making:



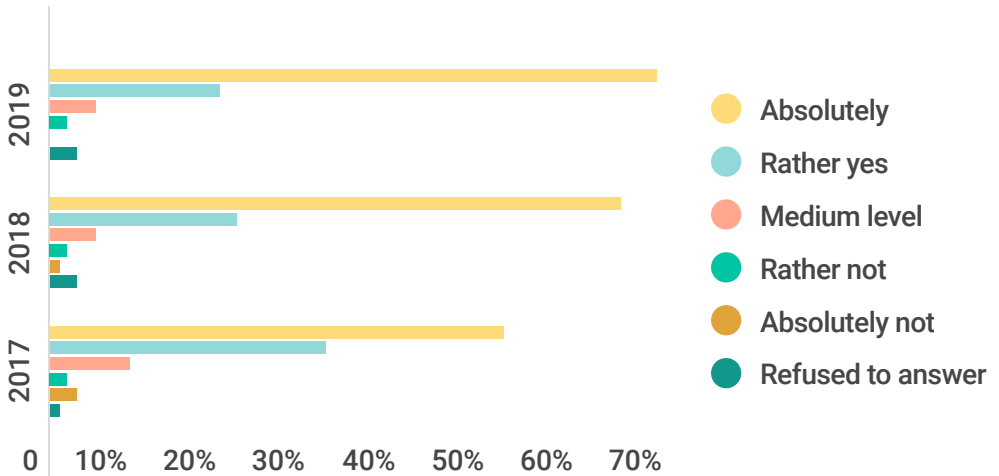

Could you see corruption risk inside the judiciary?

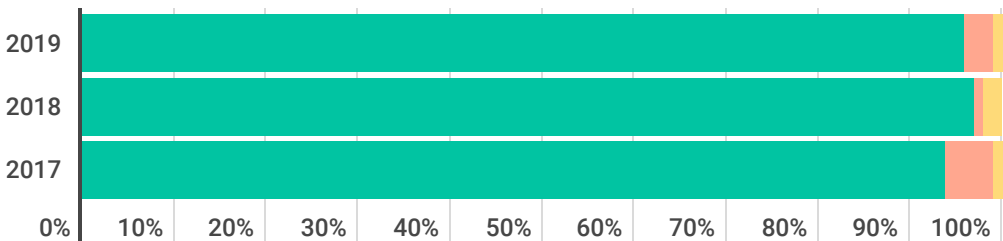
