Image and Sound Recording at Court

In relation to questions no. 1-7 and 9 please note that there is no legislation in Cyprus regulating image and voice recording at courts.

As far as questions no. 8 and 10 are concerned, there is no system under which the press is informed on current cases or substantive decisions. However, all court hearings are open to the public and in this way the press can be present and informed about the date on which a decision will be given. Under Cyprus legislation, photographs cannot be taken in court rooms.

Strengthening of Court PR: New trends of communication

Unfortunately, there are no social programmes organized by our courts in order to bring the public closer to the court or in terms of corporate social responsibility.

The courts do not use social media surfaces, but the Supreme Court of Cyprus has an official website where someone can find information about the judiciary in Cyprus and its structure and also some substantive decisions.
