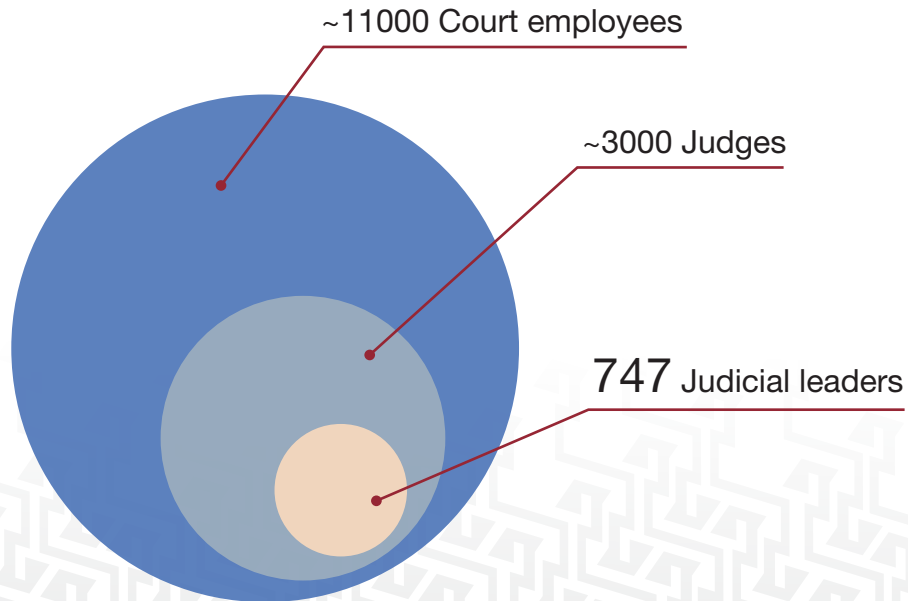

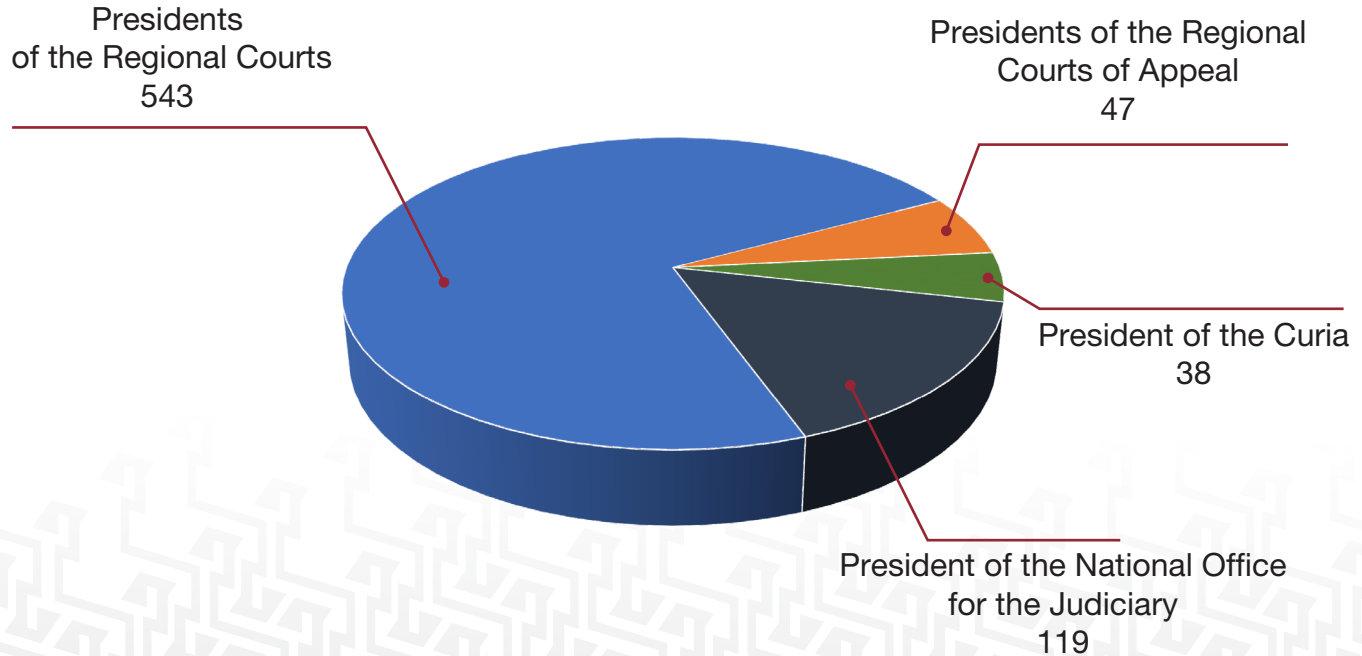

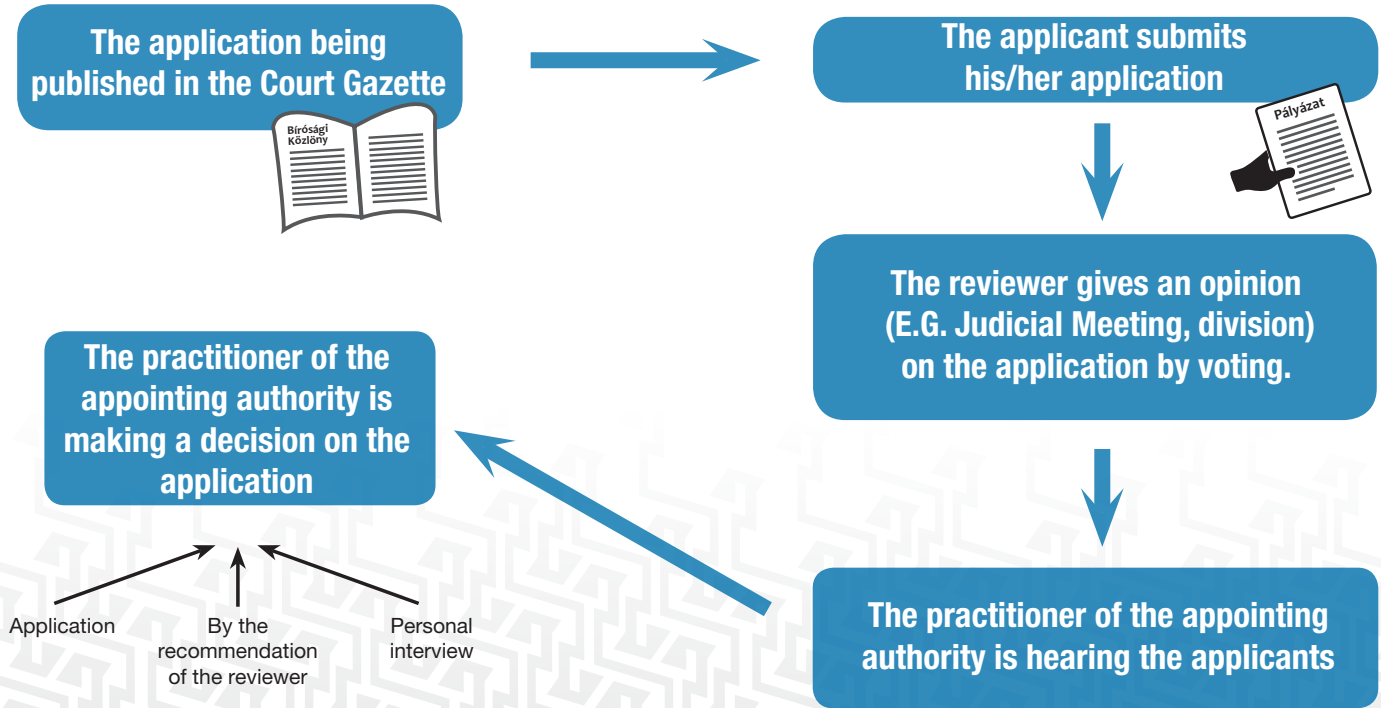

How can disagree with the reviewer's opinion?

The President of the

- Regional Courts of Appeal,

- He/she has to explain his/her decision by written.

- Curia
- National Office for the Judiciary

✓ If the applicant **have got** the majority support of the reviewer, but not has the first position of the rank,

he/she inform the National Judicial Council at the same time of his/her decision of the appointment

✗ If the applicant **haven't got** the majority support of the reviewer,

his/her appointment shall be just with the agreement of the National Judicial Council.

What are the reasons of the unsuccessful leadership applications?

- No applications.
- The practitioner of appointing authority refuse all the applications.

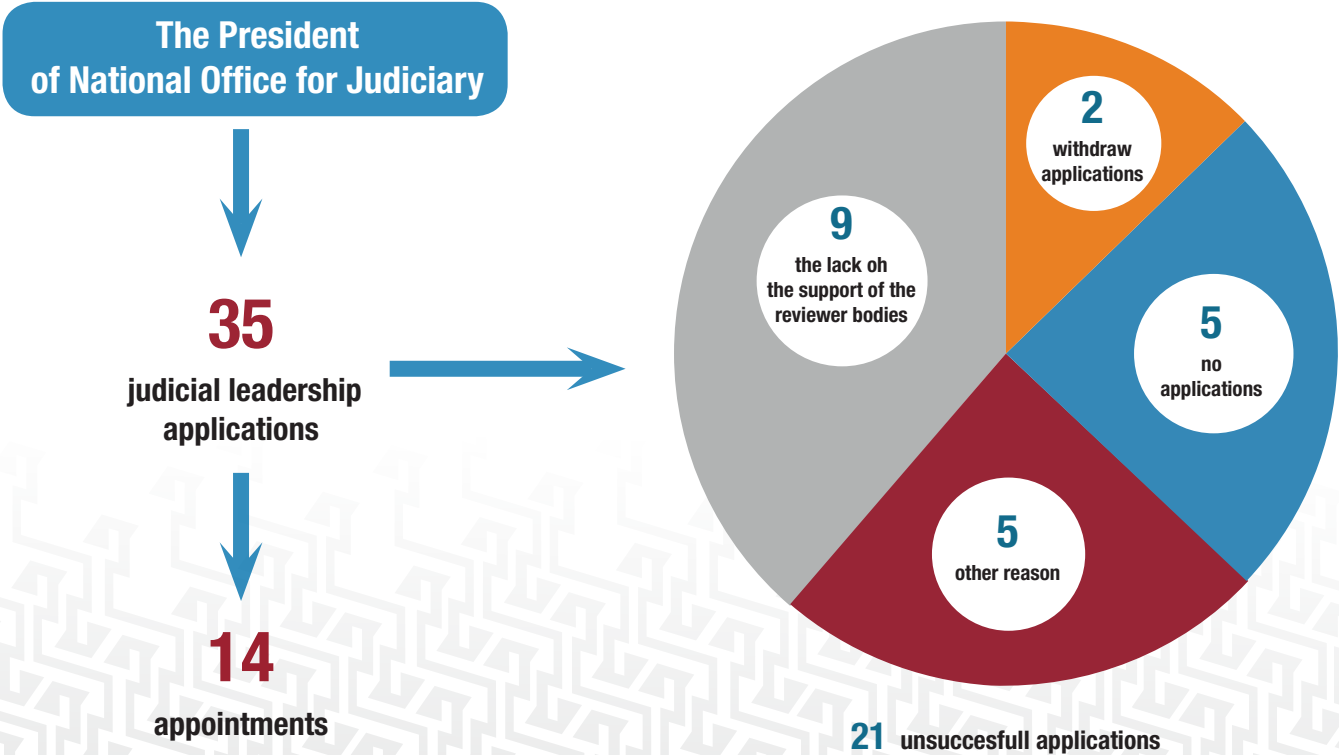
